King County Metro Awards New Contract, More Service to Veolia Transportation

Chicago, IL – King County Metro awarded its Accessible Services Program to Veolia Transportation, expanding service to 70% under the new contract. Under the old contract Veolia operated 45% of the paratransit services.

With the start of the new contract, Veolia will be adding an additional 266 drivers and 195 more vehicles to its operation. In addition to covering the inter-urban area for service, the expanded service will cover much of downtown Seattle.

In making the announcement, Veolia President Mike Griffus said, “we are extremely proud of our local team. They’ve been operating this contract since 1996 and have met and exceeded our company’s expectations for operating this service. Our General Manager Rafeh Haider and his staff have worked hard from day one to make sure the needs of both our client and our passengers are met.” Griffus also said, “we are pleased our client has renewed our contract and has entrusted us to provide more service. We look forward to continuing our long-standing partnership with King County Metro as well as the communities we service.”

The new contract which begins June 30, 2008 is for five years with (one) five-year extension option. The expanded service is expected to add 7.5 million miles annually to Veolia’s operation.
