Golden Touch Transportation of NY, a division of Veolia Transportation On Demand, was awarded a privileged permit by the Port Authority of New York and [New Jersey](#) to provide interstate express bus services to and from New York airports and Manhattan, and Weehawken, New Jersey beginning January 1, 2011. The new service will be branded [NYC](#) Airporter(TM) "Your Express Ride to New York City."

Veolia Transportation On Demand, through its division Golden Touch Transportation of [NY](#), plans to improve the existing airport services when it takes delivery of a new fleet of HYBRID buses with leather seats, Wi-Fi, overhead and rear [luggage](#) storage and power strips for all passengers to use their laptops or charge phones while on their buses. Veolia expects to take delivery on the new fleet in June 2011. Both the current and new fleet is ADA accessible.

The NYC Airporter will operate between [Manhattan](#) and La Guardia (LGA) and JFK Airports and between Weehawken, NJ to Manhattan, JFK and LGA. Low fares starting at \$12.75 one way and \$22 [round trip](#) is a third less than the cost of a cab. There are multiple value pricing options for frequent travelers, airport and [airline](#) employees, as well as family discounts.
