Veolia Transportation Wins Tempe Fixed Route Contract Renewal

Tempe, AZ – April 1, 2009 - President and COO Mike Griffus announced earlier this week that Veolia Transportation has been selected to operate Fixed Route Transit and Neighborhood Circulator service for the City of Tempe, in the Phoenix metropolitan area. This represents a contract renewal for the company, which has been operating the service since 1998.

The City of Tempe City Council approved the contract during its monthly meeting on March 26th. The new contract, which took affect April 1, 2009, has a base of 51 months with options available for an additional four years.

"This is an exciting win for Veolia Transportation because it comes as a direct result of steady performance improvements, gained via years of very hard work by local, regional and corporate staff", Griffus stated. Regional Vice President Jim Wolf added, "We're proud to have been selected once again to operate the Tempe Fixed Route Transit and Neighborhood Circulator Services. Veolia Transportation is committed to providing safe and sustainable transportation to the passengers of the Tempe services and we look forward to continuing our partnership with the City of Tempe."

Under the new contract, Veolia Transportation will continue operating bus services in and around Tempe, which is home to Arizona State University. Additionally, the company will be enhancing the already strong local management team with new talent in the areas of environmental management and sustainability, operations, IT and data analysis. Plans are also underway to implement several new technology solutions, which will assist Veolia in improving the quality of pre-trip inspection and maintenance processes, as well as fuel efficiency.
